10. Mrs. Mohini fraudulently informs Mrs. Savithri that Mohini's estate is free from incumbrance. Mrs. Savithri thereupon buys the estate. The estate is subject to a mortgage. What are the rights vested with Mrs. Savithri ? Explain.
