- 6 Explain various non constitutional mode of judicial review of administrative action.

II. Answer any *three* questions. Each question carries 10 marks :

- 7 Price of Sugar is determined by the Government without giving fair hearing to the sugar manufacturers. Decision of the Central Government was questioned before the Court of Law. Decide the case.
- 8 The Director of Public Instruction (DPI) in a state was empowered to grant exemption from the rule regarding minimum wage prescribed for appearing in an examination and it should be accompanied by the recommendation of Headmaster and certificate of physical fitness. The DPI made a rule not to grant such exemption in any case where the deficiency in age was beyond *two* years. 'X' the petitioner was not granted such exemption Advice 'X'.
- 9 A complaint was filed by X against Y an advocate for an alleged act of misconduct. A disciplinary Committee was appointed to make an inquiry into allegation made against Y. The Chairman of the Committee earlier represented the X in a Case. Y objects the Constitution of the Committee. Decide.
