8. A required B, his cashier, to furnish security for his due accounting when he committed embezzlement. C provided his guarantee for B's due accounting without knowledge of B's prior misconduct. Later, B again committed embezzlement. A filed a suit against C. Decide.

9. Manoj promises to indemnify Neeraj against the consequences of any proceedings that Praveen may take against Neeraj for recovering 5 lakh rupees. Praveen sued Neeraj and recovered the amount from him. Can Neeraj recover this amount from Manoj.
10. P, a surety, guarantees a loan procured by R from Q. Subsequently, R defaults on the loan, prompting Q to demand repayment from P. Upon this demand, P discovers that Q had previously returned certain securities that were held as collateral against the loan. Q has now initiated legal proceedings against P. Advise P
